Bridgeport Energy Corporation ("Bridgeport " or "Applicant"), by its attorney, hereby respectfully requests authority from the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points. In accordance with the Commission's fee schedule, Fee Code CUT, Bridgeport Energy Corporation has attached a check in the amount of \$780.00 to this Application.

Bridgeport Energy Corporation is a U.S. company formed on October 8, 1998 to provide telecommunications services to business and residential customers throughout the United States.
