Applicant is a nondominant carrier that has no affiliation with a foreign carrier or the U.S. facilities-based carriers whose international switched services it seeks to resell and, therefore, this application qualifies for the streamlined approval process provided in §63.12 of the Commission's rules.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Applicant.

II. SUPPORTING INFORMATION

In support of its requests for authority to resell additional international switched voice services, and pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Applicant furnishes the following information:

- (a) Applicant is network intelligence, inc. Applicant does not conduct business under any assumed names.

- (b) The Applicant is a Texas corporation formed on February 21, 1996, and issued Charter No. 1389386 by the Texas Secretary of State.

- (d) The Applicant has not previously received authority under section 214 of the Communications Act.
- (e) Applicant requests global international resale Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission's rules.
- (f) At this time, Applicant seeks no other authorization available under Section 63.18(e).
- (g) Applicant is not seeking facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(6).
The proposed service will be between Applicant's resale facilities in the United States and other countries served by the underlying carriers.
- (h) Applicant is not, and has no affiliation with, a foreign carrier. No director, shareholder, or officer of the Applicant is an agent of a foreign carrier.
Certification of this fact may be found at "Attachment A" to this application.

(i) The Applicant has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which the Applicant may serve under the authority granted under this part and will not enter into such agreements in the future.

(j) In accordance with §63.12(j) of the Commission's Rules, Applicant states that no party to the application has been denied federal benefits pursuant to §5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act. Certification of this fact may be found at "Attachment A" to this application.

The public need will be served by the grant of 214 authority to Applicant because end users of Applicant's telecommunications services require the convenience of calling international points for both business and personal reasons. It is in the public interest to permit resellers of long distance service, such as Applicant, flexibility to resell switched voice services of several carriers in the international markets served by its underlying carrier(s) in order to better serve the needs of their customers. Further, increased competition in these markets will serve to increase the service offerings available as well as reduce the cost of international telecommunication services to end users.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission authorize Applicant to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international switched services to international points served by said carriers in compliance with terms and conditions of Section 63.12(e)(2).

Applicant further requests that this application be processed under the streamlined approval process described in §63.12 of the Commission's rules.

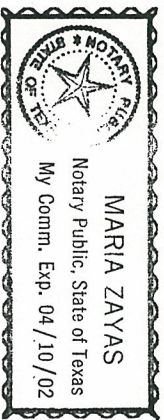
