APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

Advanced Remote Communications Solutions, Inc. ("ARCOMS"), hereby requests authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.12, for global authority to provide facilities based international switched communications services, including international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services and to resell the international services of other common carriers for the provision of such services.

ARCOMS's provision of international service will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. Additional competition in the market - including the competition ARCOMS will provide - benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service options. ARCOMS submits therefore, that grant of this application will serve the public interest convenience and necessity and requests that it be processed pursuant to the streamlined procedures applicable to non-dominant carriers. See §63.12 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.12. Pursuant to §63.18 of the Commission

Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.18, ARCOMS submits the following in support of its request for authorization.

(d) ARCOMS has not previously received authority under §214 and will be a non-dominant carrier subject to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214 (1982) as a result of the proposed international operations.

(e) ARCOMS is requesting Section 214 authority to operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of §63.18(e)(1) and to operate as a resale carrier

pursuant to 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.18(e)(1) and (2).

(f) ARCOMS certifies that it will comply with the terms and conditions contained in §§63.21, 63.22 and 63.23 as adopted in 1998 Biennial Regulatory Review - Review of International Common Carrier Authorizations, FCC 99-51, released March 23, 1999, 64 Fed. Reg. 19057-15067, April 19, 1999.

(g) The public interest, convenience and necessity will be served by the grant of this application. Grant of this application will bring to the marketplace a variety of alternative competitive international telecommunications services. Consumers of telecommunications services will benefit from the increased price competition and the increased availability of services.

(h) ARCOMS certifies that it has no affiliation with any foreign carrier. ARCOMS further certifies that it has no affiliation with any U.S. carriers whose facilities-based international service(s) it proposes to resell.

(i) ARCOMS certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which ARCOMS may serve under the authority requested herein and that it will not enter into such agreements in the future.
