**APPLICATION**

Worldwide Caribbean Communications Services Inc. ("WCCS), hereby request authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982) and Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R.
