<sup>1</sup> The instant authorization was previously held by Eastern Kansas Holdings, Inc. ("Eastern Kansas"). *See* Public Notice, DA 09-2331, dated October 29, 2009 at 3. Eastern Kansas' then wholly-owned subsidiary, S&A Communications, Inc. dba S&A Long Distance ("S&A") (which is now a wholly subsidiary of ABAC), operated under that authority effective January 1, 2007. ABAC notes that the Section 63.21(h) notification had not been filed indicating that S&A was operating under Eastern Kansas' authority issued in File No. ITC-214-20000310-00140, and regrets that this inadvertent oversight occurred. This notification corrects this inadvertent oversight.
