**APPLICATION FOR STREAMLINED
INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 AUTHORIZATION**

C-R Long Distance, Inc. ("CRLD" or "Applicant") requests authorization, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, to resell the switched international telecommunications services of other common carriers between the United States and international points. See 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1988); International Section 214 Streamlining Order, 61 Fed. Reg. 15,724, 15,729 (1995) (codified at 47 C.F.R. § 63.18).

CRLD requests authorization to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Rules. Unless formally opposed, the present application qualifies for streamlined treatment under Section 63.12 of the Rules. See International Section 214 Streamlining Order, supra at 15,728 (codified at 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.12).

CRLD's proposed resale of telecommunications services will augment international telecommunications competition and, consequently, the public interest will be enhanced. CRLD will purchase switched telecommunications services at volume discounts, and resell the services to its customers with efficient incorporation of its savings. The public interest will be served through CRLD's offering of rates that will be competitive with other similarly situated telecommunications carriers. CRLD's resale operations will encourage competition in the telecommunications market through the introduction of telecommunications innovation and the rapid implementation of cost

sensitive pricing for the benefit of the public.

Grant of this application will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity and in support thereof, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules:

- CRLD: (1) will maintain separate books of account from its affiliated local exchange carriers;
- (2) will not jointly own transmission or switching facilities with its affiliated local exchange carriers; and
- (3) will take any tariffed services from its affiliated local exchange carriers pursuant to the terms and conditions of their generally applicable tariffs.
- CRLD will be treated as a nonregulated affiliate of its affiliated local exchange carriers for purposes of local exchange carrier accounting under the Commission's joint cost and affiliate transactions rules as set forth in Parts 32 and 64 of the Commission's Rules.

Foreign Concessions and Arrangements

CRLD hereby certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or foreign administration with respect to traffic and revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which the Applicant may serve under the authority sought, and that it will not enter into such agreements in the future.


Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification
