Application

Lerner Overseas Telecommunications, Inc. ("Lerner") hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

Lerner is a U.S. company organized in 1993 to provide telecommunications services. (Lerner has no foreign affiliations.) Lerner intends to serve business customers throughout the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Lerner.

The following information is submitted, as required by Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, in support of Lerner's request for authorization.

(e) Lerner requests global facilities-based and resale Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) and (e)(2) of the Commissions Rules.

(f) At this time, Lerner seeks no other authorization available under Section 63.18(e).

(g) Not applicable.

(h) Lerner certifies that it is not affiliated with any foreign or U.S. facilities-based carrier.
