Integration Services International, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as

"ISI") hereby applies for authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the  
Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), and Section 63.18 of the  
Commission's Rules and Regulations (the "Rules"), to: (1) acquire and operate  
U.S. common carrier and non-common carrier facilities previously and  
subsequently authorized by the Commission to provide telecommunications  
services between the United States and all permissible foreign points, and (2)  
resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers --  
including, consistent with the Commission's Report and Order and Order on  
Reconsideration in Rules and Policies on Foreign Participation in the U.S.  
Telecommunications Market,<sup>1/</sup> the resale of private line services for the  
provision of international basic switched services to certain countries -- to all  
international points.

In accordance with Section 63.18 of the Rules, ISI submits the following information in support of its application:

- (a) The applicant is Integration Services International, Inc. The Company's address is: 5100 NW 33rd Ave., Suite 250, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33309. The phone number at that address is (954) 735-1005.

- (b) ISI is a Florida corporation.

- (d) ISI has not received authority previously under Section 214 of the Act. As a non-dominant carrier, ISI may acquire facilities to provide domestic common carrier services without obtaining certification pursuant to Section 214.<sup>2/</sup> Under Section 63.12 of the Rules, this application is subject to the Commission's streamlined processing rules as ISI is a non-dominant carrier,

pursuant to Section 63.10 of the Rules, and is not otherwise affiliated with a foreign carrier.


(e) ISI hereby requests Section 214 authority:

- (1) to operate as a facilities-based international carrier between the United States and all permissible points, pursuant to the terms and conditions of Sections 63.18(e)(1), 63.21, and 63.22 of the Rules, as well as to any and all other provisions of the Rules applicable hereto;
- (2) to resell international services, between the United States and all permissible points -- including, consistent with the Foreign Participation Order, the resale of private line services for the provision of international basic switched services to certain countries -- pursuant to the terms and conditions of Sections 63.18(e)(2), 63.21, and 63.23 of the Rules, as well as any and all other provisions of the Rules applicable hereto.

The authorization sought in this application will be used to provide a full range of telecommunications services, including switched voice and data, private line and business services, between the United States and all permissible foreign points.

- (f) ISI hereby certifies, under penalty of perjury, that it has no affiliation with any foreign carrier. The following owns and controls 100% of ISI:

(g) ISI hereby certifies, under penalty of perjury, that it has not agreed to accept -- nor will it agree to accept -- special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country that ISI may serve under the authority granted pursuant to Part 47 of the Rules.

(h) Pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Rules, by certification attached hereto, ISI certifies that no party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits that includes FCC benefits pursuant to section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

As demonstrated herein, ISI is legally and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. The grant of this application will serve the public interest by promoting increased competition in the international telecommunications marketplace.

By this application, ISI respectfully requests that the Commission grant it authority to acquire and operate U.S. common carrier and non-common carrier facilities previously and subsequently authorized by the Commission, and to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers -- including, consistent with the Foreign Participation Order, the resale of private

line services for the provision of international basic switched services to certain countries -- to all international points.
