APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

Wireless Roaming Corp. ("WRC"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

WRC is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Delaware and authorized to provide international telecommunications services. WRC has no foreign affiliates. The company seeks to provide international telecommunications services in order to better serve its customers by broadening its scope of telecommunications products and services. By providing international services, WRC will be able to offer its customers a valuable service at competitive rates. Such a result will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market.

The provision of international service by WRC will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. However, additional competition in the market, including the competition of WRC, benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service options. Thus, the grant of the requested Section 214 authorization is consistent with the public interest.

In support of WRC's request for authorization, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R. 63.18:
