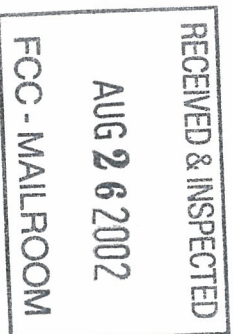

**Re: Section 214 Authorization, File No. ITC-214-20000417-00267, and Notification of TELUS Communications (Québec) Inc., Québec-Communications Inc. and, TELUS Solutions (Québec) Inc., wholly owned TELUS Subsidiaries**

This letter is notice that there are additional TELUS Corporation ("TELUS") wholly owned subsidiaries using TELUS' section 214 authorization. TELUS is providing the information below, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. sec. 63.21.

As noted in our letter of October 19, 2000, because TELUS is a holding company, and not a carrier, TELUS will provide no telecommunications service directly as a result of the "pro forma" assignment of TELUS Communications (B.C.) Inc.'s Section 214 authorization to TELUS on October 1, 2000. Instead, TELUS provides all services through several, directly or indirectly held, wholly owned subsidiaries, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. s.63.21 (i). Such subsidiaries previously identified to the FCC are TELUS Communications Inc., TELUS Services Inc., TELUS Enterprises Inc., and PSINet Canada Inc. (PSINet Canada Inc. changed its name to 3944786 Canada Inc. effective July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2002.)

This is notice that the TELUS wholly owned subsidiaries, TELUS Communications (Québec) Inc., Québec-Communications Inc. and, TELUS Solutions (Québec) Inc., all Canadian companies, are also operating under the Section 214 authorization held by TELUS.
