APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

iTelco Communications, Inc. ("Applicant"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to resell the international telecommunications services of other common carriers between the United States and various international points.

iTelco Communications, Inc. is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of California on August 30, 1999 under the name UMcenter, Inc. On November 10, 1999, the name was changed to iTelco Communications, Inc. The Applicant intends to resell the telecommunications services of other common carriers and is not a facilities-based carrier. iTelco Communications, Inc.'s service will be offered for use by end user customers. Through iTelco Communications, Inc.'s service, customers may originate calls from locations within the United States (initially California) to other countries, and from foreign locations to terminate in the United States. The Applicant seeks authority to resell international telecommunications services to better serve its customers by offering various call termination options. By providing international calling services, iTelco Communications, Inc. will be able to offer its customers valuable service at competitive rates.

International telecommunications services will be obtained by iTelco Communications, Inc. from other common carriers who are currently authorized by the Commission to provide international service. Initially, iTelco Communications, Inc. will only resell international switched services. However, iTelco Communications, Inc. requests authority to resell private line service in the future as contemplated under Section 63.18 (e) (2) and subject to the restrictions imposed therein.

The provision of international service by iTelco Communications, Inc. will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. However, additional competition in the market - including the competition of iTelco Communications, Inc. - benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service options. Thus, the grant of this authorization is consistent with the public interest.

In support of iTelco Communications, Inc.'s request for authorization, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18.

Specifically, iTelco Communications, Inc. proposes to resell the international services of any authorized common carrier pursuant to tariff or contract duly filed with the Commission, for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business service to all international points, as authorized by the Commission.

- (g) iTelco Communications, Inc. does not seek facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(6).

(h) iTelco Communications, Inc. certifies that it is not a foreign carrier nor is iTelco Communications, Inc. affiliated with any foreign carrier. Applicant has no directly affiliation with any U.S. Carriers whose facilities-based services iTelco Communications, Inc. proposes to resell. However, two of iTelco Communications, Inc.'s principals are also principals of OpenTel Communications, Inc., a US carrier whose services iTelco Communications, Inc. intends to use the provision of its services. Pursuant to Section 63.50 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.50, Applicant, by its attorneys, hereby amends the above referenced application. The information is presented in the order in which it appears in IBFS Format.

- Main Form, Item 7 should read as follows: "All international points except Malaysia and Guinea."
- Main Form, Item 8 should read as follows: "Application for authority to provide global facilities-based and resold international switched services to all international points except those in Malaysia and Guinea."
- Main Form, Item 12 should read "Yes,"
- Attachment 1, "Response to Item 9" should read:

iTOPIA seeks streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules. As discussed below, on the international routes for which it seeks authorization, iTOPIA qualifies for a presumption of non-dominance under Section 63.10(a)(3) and its foreign carrier affiliates hold only mobile wireless facilities in the relevant destination markets.

- Attachment 1, “Response to Item 11” should read:

Applicant iTOPIA hereby certifies that it is affiliated with the following foreign carriers (with the applicable destination country) by virtue of Telekom Malaysia’s non-controlling 34.7% ownership interest in iTOPIA: TM International (Bangladesh) Ltd. (Bangladesh); Cambodia Samart Communication Co., Ltd. (Cambodia); Societe Des Telecommunications Guinee (Guinea); Usha Martin Telekom Limited (India); Telekom Networks Limited, Malawi (Malawi); Telekom Malaysia (Malaysia); and MTN Networks (Private) Ltd. (Sri Lanka). As Telekom Malaysia holds controlling interests in these carriers, iTOPIA is affiliated with them pursuant to Section 63.09 of the Commission’s rules.

Each of the above-referenced countries except Cambodia is a WTO Member. In all countries for which iTOPIA seeks authorization in the instant application, the affiliated foreign carrier affiliate lacks 50 percent market share in the international transport and the local access markets on the foreign end of the route and thus lacks market power; iTOPIA is therefore presumptively non-dominant. Furthermore, all of the above-referenced foreign carrier affiliates, except those in Malaysia and Guinea, are mobile wireless service providers.¹

- Attachment 1, “Response to Items 12-13” should read:

iTOPIA seeks authorization to provide service to all of the destinations listed above in response to Item 11 except Malaysia and Guinea.

¹Telekom Malaysia’s Malawi affiliate provides some data packet switching services as well. The Malawi Post and Telecommunication Corporation, however, remains the dominant carrier in international transport and the local access markets.
