Moundridge Telecom, Inc. ("Moundridge"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

Moundridge Telecom, Inc. is a corporate subsidiary of Moundridge Telephone Company, an entity holding certificates of convenience and authority from the Kansas Corporation Commission to operate as a telecommunications public utility within the State of Kansas.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Moundridge.


(j) Moundridge certifies that no party to this application has been denied federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
