SOLE WIN ENTERPRISES CO., LTD. d/b/a Sinotel Global

("SINOTEL") hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the
Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C.A. § 214, and § 63.18 of
the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to provide global international
facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international
points.

SINOTEL is a company organized to provide international services
to consumers and businesses. By granting this application, the Commission will
serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in
the international market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing
service options and lowering prices.

And SINOTEL does not seek authority to provide switched basic services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched services over private lines.

CONCLUSION

SINOTEL submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be served by a grant of the authority requested in this Section 214 application, because granting such authority will promote increased competition in the international telecommunications market, and thus promote competitive pricing and increased service options. SINOTEL further certifies that all of the information contained herein is accurate and correct.

Accordingly, SINOTEL respectfully requests that the Commission grant the authority requested in this application.


