

**APPLICATION**

USGATEWAY NETWORKS, Inc. (“USGN” or “Applicant”), by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), 47 U.S.C. § 214, hereby requests authority to (1) operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission’s Rules, and (2) operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission’s Rules.<sup>1</sup>

USGN has no affiliation with any foreign carrier in any of the destination countries for which authority is requested, nor is USGN affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose services USGN may resell. As a result, pursuant to Section 63.10(a)(1) of the Commission’s Rules, USGN should be classified as a nondominant carrier in its provision of international service on all routes.

Furthermore, this Application is entitled to streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the

Commission's Rules.

(e) USGN is applying for authority to operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission's Rules and as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules. USGN requests authority to serve all countries possible under a grant of global authority. As evidenced by the certification provided in Attachment A, USGN will comply with the terms and conditions contained in Sections 63.21, 63.22, and 63.23 of the Commission's Rules.

(f) No response required.




- (g) USGN will use previously authorized facilities to provide its facilities-based services and thus this Application is categorically excluded from environmental assessment pursuant to Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules.
- (h) USGN is 100% owned by Michael F. Henry, a U.S. citizen. Mr. Henry's principal business is Telecommunications. Mr. Henry has less than a ten percent (10%) ownership interest in Gateway Telephone Limited, a Canadian competitive local exchange carrier, for which Mr. Henry serves as the Chief Technical Officer. Gateway Telephone Limited is a privately held company. Mr. Henry may be reached at 1750 St Charles #308, New Orleans, Louisiana 70115 504-200-2237.
- (i) As evidenced by the certification provided in Attachment A, USGN is not affiliated with any foreign carrier.
- (j), (k), (l), and (m):  
Not applicable; USGN is not affiliated or otherwise related to any foreign carrier on any of the routes USGN proposes to serve in this Application.
- (n) As evidenced by the certification provided in Attachment A, USGN has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses sufficient market power on the foreign end of the route to affect competition adversely in the U.S. market and will not enter into such agreements in the future.


