PowerCom Energy & Communications Access Inc. ("PowerCom"), hereby requests authority to Section 214 of the Communication's Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to requests services or facilities not covered by a global authorization, interconnected private line resale, and acquiring facilities through transfer of control or assignment of authorization within the United States and other territories.
