APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

Global Gateway Communications, Inc. hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and 47 C.F.R., Section 63.18 (1995) to: 1) as provided by 47 C.F.R., Section 63.18(e) (1) to acquire ownership interest in U.S. authorized international facilities not included on the FCC Exclusion List to provide international telecommunications services to all international points; 2) to resell international long distance services of other common carriers between the United States and all international points not excluded; and 3) resell international switched services of all unaffiliated carriers authorized to provide such services between the United States and all international points not on the exclusion list.

Global Gateway Communications, Inc. ("GGC") is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Nevada. The company intends to provide facility-based telecommunications services and to resell switched telecommunications services of common carriers. GGC's customer base will be located throughout the country. The company seeks authority to resell international interconnected private line to provide services to better serve the needs of its customers by offering a full range of competitively priced international telecommunications products and services. GGC's customer base is primarily comprised of medium and large sized business customers engaged in international trade as well as other common carriers. By providing facility based telecommunications services, Global Gateway Communications, Inc. will be able to serve its customers more completely and remain competitive in the marketplace.

International interconnected switched and private line services to be resold will be obtained by Global Gateway Communications from other currently authorized common



carriers. In accordance with Section 63.17(b) (1995), Global Gateway Communications will engage in "switched hubbing" in selected countries.

The provision of international service by GGC will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. GGC does believe, however, that additional competition in the market benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower rates and increased availability of a variety of service options. Thus, the grant of this authorization is consistent with the public interest.

In support of GGC's request for authorization, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules:

- (b) Global Gateway Communications, Inc. is organized under the laws of the state of Nevada.

- (d) The applicant has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Act.
- (e) The applicant is applying authority to provide facility-based telecommunications services and resell international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points and thus is requesting Section 214 authority to operate as a facility-based and resell services of other carriers pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2).
- (f) The applicant understands and intends to comply with the following:

(1) that the applicant may provide facility-based telecommunications and resell private line services of any authorized common carrier, except affiliated carriers regulated as dominant on the route to be served,

pursuant to that carrier's tariff or contract duly filed with the Commission, for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points.

(2) that the applicant may sell facility-based telecommunications services or resell private line services for the provision of international basic switched services only to countries found by the Commission to provide equivalent resell opportunities, except in circumstances where the applicant is affiliated with a facilities-based foreign carrier in a destination market and the Commission has not determined that foreign carrier does not possess market power in that market. In such circumstances, the applicant will not commence service on any such route unless it receives specific authority to do so under paragraph (e)((6) of Section 63.18; and

(3) that the applicant understands that the authority granted under this paragraph shall be subject to all Commission's rules and the regulations and any conditions stated in the Commission's public notice or order that serves as the applicant's Section 214 certificate.

(g) The applicant, at this time, is not applying for authority to resell services or to provide private lines for the purpose of providing international basic switched services to countries not on the Commission's published list of equivalent countries..

(h) The applicant, at this time, is not applying for authority to acquire facilities through the transfer of control of common carrier holding international Section 214 authorization, or through the assignment of another carrier's existing authorization.

(i) The applicant, at this time, is not applying for authority to acquire facilities nor to provide services not covered by Section 63.18(e)(1) through (5).

(j) The applicant certifies that all of its shareholders are U.S. citizens. Shareholders with 10% or more ownership are listed below:

(k) The applicant certifies that it does not have an affiliation with a foreign carrier.

(l) The applicant certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which the



applicant may serve under the authority granted under this part and will not enter into such agreements in the future..

- (m) The applicant certifies that pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of this Chapter 63.01 etc. that no party to the application is subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti Drug Abuse Act of 1988. Cite:21 U.S.C. 853a.

The original of this application and six (6) copies of the same, are included in this package.

#### Conclusion

As demonstrated in this application, Global Gateway Communications, Inc. is legally, financially and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. For the reasons stated above, applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Section 214 application.


