APPLICATION OF TELNET, INC.

TelNet, Inc. ("TelNet" or "Applicant") hereby applies for authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1999) ("Act"), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18 (1999), for authority to provide international facilities-based services and international switched resale services on a global basis.

A grant of this application will enable TelNet to enter into the global competitive telecommunications marketplace. This will further the Commission's pro-competitive policies and serve the public interest by bringing the benefits of increased customer choice and alternative services by new entrants to the international marketplace. RCA Communications, Inc. v. F.C.C., 346 U.S. 86 (1953); and Telocator Network of America v. F.C.C., 691 F.2d 525 (D.C. Cir. 1982).

Applicant is eligible for streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12 (1999), and has no affiliation within the meaning of Section 63.18(i) with a foreign carrier, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(i) (1999).


