Pursuant to Section 63.24(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.24(b), Verizon Wireless Puerto Rico, Inc. ("WVPR" or "Assignor") and PRT Larga Distancia, Inc. ("PRTLTD" or "Assignee"), by their attorney, hereby notify the Commission of the *pro forma* assignment of the above-referenced international Section 214 authorizations, effective May 1, 2002.

WVPR was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Telecomunicaciones de Puerto Rico, Inc. ("TELPRI") authorized to provide, among other services, international long distance services. PRTLTD is also a wholly-owned subsidiary of TELPRI. Because of a corporate reorganization, the above-referenced authorizations were assigned from one wholly-owned TELPRI subsidiary to another wholly-owned TELPRI subsidiary.

The assignment of the authorizations to PRTLTD is therefore *pro forma* in nature, pursuant to Section 63.24 (a)(4) of the Commission's Rules. A certification that the assignment is *pro forma*, as defined in Section 63.24(a) of the Commission's Rules, and, together with all previous *pro forma* transactions, does not result in a change of the carrier's ultimate control is attached.

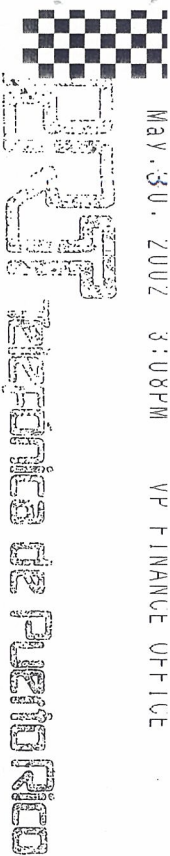




