APPLICATION

Rocatel, Inc. ("Rocatel") hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international resale services between the United States and international points.

Rocatel is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Georgia. The company intends to resell the telecommunications services of other common carriers. Through its service, Rocatel's customers may originate calls nationwide or in other countries for termination in the United States or in other countries.

Rocatel will obtain international telecommunications services from other FCC authorized international common carriers such as, but not limited to, MCI/Worldcom. The provision of international service by Rocatel will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. However, additional competition in the market will benefit consumers of international telecommunications services. These benefits include lower prices and increased

availability of a variety of service options. Therefore, the granting of this authorization to Rocatel is consistent with the public interest.


