Section 214 (1982) and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47C.F.R. Section 63.18 (the "Communications Act"), to provide global international resale services between the United States and international points.

Applicants is a new U.S. corporation organized to provide international telecommunications services.

Applicant has no foreign affiliations.

Applicant services a cross-section of residential and business customers (but mostly business customers) throughout the United States.

Applicant previously has not been granted Section 214 authority or any other authority under the Communications Act.

By granting this Application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by (i) allowing new entrants into this business which will serve to maintain the balance between large and dominant players and such new entrepreneurial companies offering state of the art solutions and economies of operations which will benefit the general public, and (ii) promoting competition in the international services

market. These increased service offerings, economies of operations and competition will benefit U.S. customers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Applicant.
