Dear Honorable Secretary Salas:

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, Intelig Telecomunicacões Ltda. ("Intelig") hereby submits for filing one original and five copies of this letter to correct its amended application to acquire facilities and provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points except between the U.S. and France, Argentina, French Guiana, Equitorial Guinea, Reunion Island, French Polynesia, New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Wallis and Futuna, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, and St. Pierre and Miquelon ("Excepted Countries"). The following countries should be added to Intelig's list of Excepted Countries: Jordan, Central African Republic, Chad, Cote d'Ivoire, Djibouti, El Salvador, Madagascar and Senegal.

Intelig also seeks to correct its application to operate as an international resale carrier between the U.S. and Central African Republic, Chad, Cote d'Ivoire, Djibouti, El Salvador, French Guiana, French Polynesia, Guadeloupe, Madagascar, Martinique, Mayotte, New Caledonia, Reunion Island, Saint Pierre and Miquelon, Senegal and Wallis and Futuna ("Intelig Destination Countries"). The following countries should be added to Intelig's list of Destination Countries: Jordan. The caption of this application should also be corrected to state that Intelig is applying "for authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to operate as an international resale carrier."

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated in the applications filed on September 1, 2000, Intelig respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Applications with the above noted corrections.
