APPLICATION

Atlas Telecom Network, Inc (“ATN” or “Applicant”), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the “Act”), 47 U.S.C. §214, hereby requests Authority to (1) operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission’s Rules, and (2) operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission’s Rules.¹ ATN has no affiliation with any foreign carrier in any of the destination countries for which authority is requested, nor is ATN affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose services ATN may resell. Thus, pursuant to Section 63.10(a)(1) of the Commission’s Rules, ATN should be classified as a nondominant carrier in its provision of international service on all routes. Furthermore, this Application is entitled to streamlined processing under Section 63.12 if the Commission’s Rules.

¹ With respect to the provision of switched services over private lines, ATN seeks authority in this Application to provide such services only to those particular locations specifically approved by the Commission for the provision of such services.

Pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, ATN sets forth the following information in support of this Application:

- (g) Atlas Telecom Network, Inc will use previously authorized facilities to provide its facilities-based services and thus this Application is categorically excluded from environmental assessment pursuant to Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules.


