

(e) By this Application, Basic requests global facilities-based and resale Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) and (2) of the Commission's Rules.

(f) The authority sought by this Application will be used to provide facilities-based and resold international message toll services ("IMTS") from points located in the United States to international points covered by this application utilizing appropriately licensed U.S. common and non-common carrier facilities.

(g) Basic certifies that it is not directly or indirectly controlled by any foreign carrier nor does it have a controlling interest in any foreign carrier or in any entity that directly or indirectly controls or is controlled by a foreign carrier. Basic has no affiliation with any foreign carrier.

(h) As President of Basic, I certify that Basic has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which Applicant may serve under the authority granted under Part 63 of the Rules and will not enter into such agreements in the future.

(i) As President of Basic, I certify that neither the Applicant, nor any officer, director, or shareholder holding 5% or more of the outstanding voting and/or non-voting stock of the corporate applicant is subject to a denial of federal benefits, including FCC benefits, pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 853a.


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CONCLUSION
