**Application**

Cal-Ore Long Distance hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international resale services between the United States and international points.

Cal-Ore Long Distance is a new U.S. company organized to provide international telecommunications services and has no foreign affiliations. Cal-Ore Long Distance serves both business and residential customers in California.
