Section 214 (1982)*, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

QTech is a new U.S. company organized to provide international telecommunications services. QTech has no foreign affiliations. QTech serves its business customers throughout the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. 
Conclusion
