This letter provides notification that Delta Telephone Company, Inc. ("Delta"), one of the providers of global resale service under the above-referenced international Section 214 authorization held by Telepak Networks, Inc. ("Telepak"), has been merged into Franklin Telephone Company, Inc. ("Franklin"). Both Delta and Franklin are corporations organized under the laws of Mississippi. On January 1, 2018, Delta was merged into Franklin with Franklin being the surviving entity.

This merger represents no transfer of control. As reflected in the Commission's files, the ultimate controlling company is Telapex, Inc. Each of the companies that relies upon the international Section 214 authorization held by Telepak, including Franklin, is a direct or indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of Telapex. Franklin will continue to provide global resale service under the Telepak international Section 214 authorization.
