APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

NORTHEASTERN UNIVERSAL SOFTWARE, INC. ("Applicant") by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (47 U.S.C. §214), hereby requests global international authorization to provide common carrier communications services (both facilities-based and resale) between the United States, its territories or possessions, and foreign points. Applicant is a computer software and network consulting company that desires to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television, and business services to international points on a facilities-based and resale basis. Approval of this application will increase competition in the U.S. international telecommunications services market which will benefit consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices, increased availability of a wider variety of service options, and more efficient use of international facilities. Thus, the grant of this authorization will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
