Mountain View Telephone Company hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international resale services between the United States and international points.

Mountain View Telephone Company is an Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier that wishes to provide international telecommunications services. Mountain View Telephone Company has no foreign affiliations. Mountain View Telephone Company serves residential and business customers in Arkansas.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to South Arkansas Telephone Company.
