Correction Regarding Surrender of International Section 214 Authority

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The undersigned counsel, on behalf of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") and its indirect wholly-owned subsidiary SunCom Wireless License Company, LLC ("SunCom"), filed a letter on August 5, 2009 surrendering SunCom's international Section 214 authorization referenced above (the "Authorization"), effective as of July 6, 2009.¹ SunCom was not dissolved as a result of an internal corporate reorganization as reported in the letter, and SunCom continues to operate. The surrender of the Authorization, however, remains effective as of July 6, 2009.

T-Mobile clarifies that pursuant to Section 63.21(h) of the Commission's rules, upon surrender of the Authorization SunCom began operating and continues to operate under T-Mobile's international Section 214 authorizations, File No. ITC-214-19960930-00473 and File No. ITC-214-20061004-00452.
