AS AN INTERNATIONAL RESELLER

NOW COMES, Telegenius, Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its representative, Telecom Certification & Filing, Inc., pursuant to § 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, makes this Application to the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") for global international resale authority between the United States and international points. In support of its Application, Applicant provides the following information as set forth pursuant to

- e. Applicant hereby requests Section 214 authority to operate as a global reseller of international telecommunications services pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's rules.

f. At this time, Applicant is not applying for any other authority set forth in paragraph (e) of Section 63.18.

g. Applicant is not seeking facilities-based authority under paragraph (e)(4) of Section 63.18.

h. Applicant hereby certifies that it is entirely a domestic company with no foreign affiliations.

j. Applicant does not seek to provide international telecommunications services to any destination country where:

(1) Applicant is a foreign carrier in that country; or

(2) Applicant controls a foreign carrier in that country; or

(3) Any entity that owns more than 25 percent of the Applicant, or that controls the Applicant, controls a foreign carrier in that country; or

(4) Two or more foreign carriers (or parties that control foreign carriers) own, in the aggregate, more than 25 percent of the Applicant and are parties to, or the beneficiaries of, a contractual relation affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.

k. Applicant is not, nor is affiliated with, a foreign carrier.

p. This Application qualifies for streamlined processing pursuant to § 63.12 of the Commission's Rules as Applicant is not affiliated with a foreign carrier in any destination market.


CONCLUSION

Applicant believes that there is significant potential for continued growth in the international voice market and that this market expansion will be accelerated by additional competition by new entrants. This position is consistent with the Commission's findings that increased competition in international markets benefits the public interest. Applicant is legally, financially and technically qualified to provide the service for which it requests global resale authority. For the reasons stated above, Applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by granting Applicant's § 214 Application. The request for global resale authorization should, therefore, be issued to Applicant for the purpose of providing resold switchless voice communications from the United States to international points.




