I. Introduction

Upon grant of this application, Sirius Telecom will become a non-dominant facilities-based carrier and reseller authorized to provide international services between the United States and all authorized international points. Sirius Telecom lacks the market power that would allow it to control prices to the detriment of market competition. Sirius Telecom believes that the added competition that its entry will bring to the market will benefit the consumers of the United States international communication services. These benefits include competitive pricing and increased availability of a variety of service options. The public interest in more economical and competitive international communication services is well established and has been addressed by the Commission in numerous decisions. Sirius Telecom therefore submits that the streamlined granting of this application will further the public interest.

(g) Not applicable. Sirius Telecom seeks authority to acquire an interest in facilities previously authorized by the Commission.

(n) Sirius Telecom certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, as defined by the Commission's Rules, directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses sufficient market power on the foreign end of the route to adversely affect

competition in the U.S. market and will not enter into any such agreements in the future.

- (o) Sirius Telecom certifies that it is not subject to a denial of U.S. Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988. Sirius Telecom's certification pursuant to Section 1.2002 of the Commission's Rules is attached.
- (p) Sirius Telecom's application for authority pursuant to Section 214 is eligible for streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules because Sirius Telecom is not affiliated with any foreign carriers and is not seeking authority to provide International Simple Resale along routes that have not been authorized by the Commission.

CONCLUSION

As demonstrated in this application, Sirius Telecom is legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority.

Therefore, expeditious grant of this application, pursuant to streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules, is warranted and would further the public interest, convenience and necessity.
