Application

World Technology Corporation ("WORLD") (FCC Registration Number 0004-9352-19) hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

WORLD is a California corporation with no foreign affiliation. Its main business will be to service U.S. based customers and telecommunication carriers and to provide them with international termination through foreign carriers. The major foreign market WORLD seeks to engage in is the Middle East and European countries. WORLD will charge U.S. customers a per minute fee to connect them to Foreign countries. WORLD will enter into resale agreements, will enter into business contracts with Foreign and Domestic carriers to lease their infrastructure lines and will also create its own network to connect customers via voice over internet protocol.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to WORLD.

(e) WORLD requests international facilities-based and resale Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) and (e)(2) of the Commission's Rules.

(f) At this time, WORLD seeks no other authorization available under Section 63.18 other than 63.18(e)(1) and (e)(2). WORLD is concurrently seeking authorization under Section 63.01.

(i) WORLD certifies that it has not agreed and will not agree in the future to accept any direct or indirect special concessions from a foreign carrier or administration with regards to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign countries the company is authorized to serve.

(j) WORLD certifies that no party to this application has been denied federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

(k) WORLD desires streamlined processing pursuant to Sec. 63.12. The instant application qualifies for streamlined processing because: (1) WORLD has no affiliation within the meaning of Sec. 63.18(h)(1)(i) with a foreign carrier in a destination market, (2) WORLD has no affiliation within the meaning of Sec. 63.18(h)(1)(i) with a dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services the applicant seeks authority to resell (either directly or indirectly through the resale of another reseller's services, (3) WORLD does not seek authority to provide switched basic services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched services over


private lines, (4) WORLD's application is not formally opposed by a pleading, and (5) The Commission has not informed WORLD in writing, within 28 days after the date of public notice accepting the application for filing, that the application is not eligible for streamlined processing under this section.
