The purpose of this letter is to respond to your communication received by Mr. Tom Luinstra, President of America Long Distance, Inc. dated July 18, 2001.

It is my understanding that Mr. Luinstra has communicated America Long Distances Response to you inquiry which states that America Long Distance's Application for Authority Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934 requesting authority to operate as an international facilities-based and resale carrier did not contain answers to Questions 9, 14 and 15 of your website or email application form.
