The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), with the concurrence of the U.S. Department of Justice (“DOJ”), hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) of DHS’ intention to withdraw from January 12, 2005 Letter of Assurance (“LOA”) and the May 16, 2007 Commitment Letter proffered by British Telecommunications plc (BT) to DHS, DOJ, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) in connection with file numbers ITC-T/C-20041119-00460 and ITC-T/C-20070425-00162.

This has no effect on the validity of the LOA, and the assurances made therein, with respect to BT and DOJ/FBI.
