Response to question 9:

The Applicant, Stel International, Inc., qualifies for streamlined processing, pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.12 because:

- (1) Applicant is not affiliated with a foreign carrier;
- (2) Applicant has no affiliation with a dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services Applicant seeks authority to resell;
- (3) Applicant does not seek authority to provide switched basic services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched services over private lines.

Applicant also qualifies for streamlined processing pursuant to the Commission's policies implementing the WTO Basic Trade Agreement, which include a presumption that the level of foreign ownership proposed by the instant application does not pose a competitive concern.

Response to question 10:

The Applicant is not applying for authority to provide switched services over private lines.
