Reply to question 9:

The applicant qualifies for streamlined processing because:

- 1) It is not affiliated with a foreign carrier in a destination market.
- 2) It does not have an affiliation with a dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services the Applicant seeks authority to resell (either directly or indirectly through the resale of another reseller's services).
- 3) It does not seek authority to provide switched basic services over private lines to a country for which the Commission has not previously authorized the provision of switched services over private lines.

Reply to question 11:

Section 63.18 (i): O.N.Tel Inc. is not affiliated with a foreign carrier.

Section 63.18 (j): O.N.Tel Inc. seeks to provide international telecommunications services to the U.S.A. for which O.N.Tel Inc. would become a foreign carrier in the U.S.A.

Section 63.18 (k): The U.S.A. is a member of the World Trade Organization.

Section 63.18 (l): O.N.Tel Inc. does not propose to resell the international switched services of an unaffiliated U.S. carrier for the purpose of providing international telecommunications services to a country where it is a foreign carrier or is affiliated with a foreign carrier.

Section 63.18 (m): O.N.Tel Inc. is not affiliated with a foreign carrier and desires to be regulated as non-dominant for the provision of international telecommunication services to the United States and meets the requirements under section 63.10 (a) (4).

Reply to question 12:

Section 63.18 (j): O.N.Tel Inc. seeks to provide international telecommunications services to the U.S.A. for which O.N.Tel Inc. would become a foreign carrier in the U.S.A

Reply to question 15:

Section 63.18 (d): O.N.Tel Inc. has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Act.

Section 63.18 (g): O.N.Tel Inc. is not seeking facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(4). O.N.Tel Inc. is seeking authority under Section 63.18 (e)(1).
