
Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest"), QCC's parent company, withdrew its pending Section 271 applications on September 10, 2002, and the Commission subsequently terminated its proceedings in WC Docket Nos. 02-148 and 02-189.<sup>1</sup> The above-referenced applications for international Section 214 authority were filed in conjunction with those pending Section 271 applications. Due to the termination of the related Section 271 proceedings and pursuant to International Bureau staff request, QCC will withdraw the above-referenced applications, but expects to reapply for international Section 214 authority once QCI submits a new
