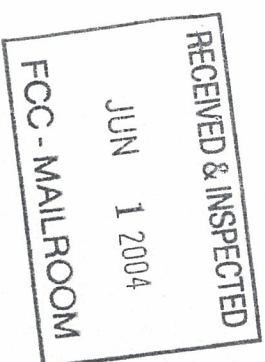

My name is Luis Coello. I am president of Telecuba, Inc., a Florida telecommunications corporation, founded in 1995, with its office at 444 Brickell Ave, Suite 700, Miami, FL 33131. Telecuba currently hold three licenses from the Department of the Treasury and one from the FCC with authorization from the Department of the Treasury. In 1997, the Department of the Treasury granted Telecuba its first travel license CT-1505 to travel to Cuba to participate in meetings and negotiate a telecommunications agreement. On October 2, 2001, Telecuba was granted license number CU-688925, which authorizes transfer of funds to Cuba routed through a third country and on April 29, 2003, License number CT-132 was granted, for the purpose of fact finding and consultations concerning the possibility of laying a fiber optic cable between the U.S. and Cuba. On May 6, 2003, Telecuba was granted a special Cuba 214 authorization, file number ITC-214-20020924-00457 to provide direct facilities based services from the U.S. to Cuba.

My current license is in the name of Telecuba. Telecuba currently operates in the name of U.S. Telecom Group I would like to request that this license be re-issued in this name. There has been no change in officers or directors. As requested by your office, enclosed find a copy of the articles of incorporation and copies of the three licenses from the U.S. Department of the Treasury mentioned above with the name changed from Telecuba to U.S. Telecom.
