APPLICATION

Time Warner Cable Information Services (Maine), LLC (“TWICIS (Maine)”) hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to (1) construct, acquire and operate U.S. common carrier and non-common carrier facilities previously and subsequently authorized by the Commission to provide telecommunications services between the United States and all permissible foreign points, and (2) resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers to all permissible foreign points.¹

¹ TWICIS (Maine) intends to provide service on an Internet Protocol basis. This application should not be construed as a concession or agreement that these services constitute telecommunications services, local exchange services, common carrier offerings, or services that are otherwise subject to federal or state regulation, nor that the entity providing them is a

TWCIS (Maine) is a Delaware limited liability corporation organized to provide, *inter alia*, international long-distance service. TWCIS (Maine) has no foreign affiliates. TWCIS (Maine) will serve business and residential customers in the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity by promoting competition in international long-distance service. Competition will benefit United States consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices.

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
