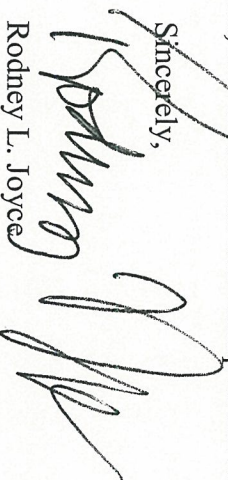

APPLICATION TO PROVIDE GLOBAL RESALE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

RGT Utilities of Connecticut, Inc. hereby applies for authorization to provide international switched telecommunications service on a resale basis. Applicant will provide service by reselling the international switched offerings of U.S. carriers with whom Applicant is not affiliated.

Applicant submits the following information in support of this application in accordance with Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules. Each paragraph below is numbered in accordance with the numbering in that Section of the Rules.

(b) Applicant is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Delaware.

(d) Applicant has not previously received an authorization under Section 214 of the Communications Act.

(e) Applicant applies for authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act to operate as a resale carrier and files this application pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules. Applicant requests that it be authorized to provide international telecommunications service between the United States and any foreign point and that it be authorized to resell the international telecommunications services of any authorized U.S. carrier with whom it has no affiliation. Applicant certifies that it will comply with the terms and conditions contained in Sections 63.21 and 63.23 of the Commission's Rules.

(f) Not applicable.

(g) Not applicable

(h) Applicant is a wholly owned subsidiary of Rockefeller Group

Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("RGTS") (a U.S. company with the same mailing address as Applicant). RGTS, in turn, is wholly owned by Rockefeller Group International, Inc. ("RGI") (a U.S. company), which is wholly owned by Rockefeller Group, Inc. ("RGI") (a U.S. company). RGI is wholly owned by Mitsubishi Estate Co., Ltd. ("MEC") (a publicly traded Japanese company). It appears, based on MEC's most recent Annual Report, that no party owns 10 percent or more of MEC's shares. RGTS's primary business is the rental of telecommunications equipment. MEC's primary business is real estate.

(i) Neither Applicant, RGTS, nor RGI is authorized to provide telecommunications service in any foreign country. MEC is authorized to provide telecommunications service in Japan, and three affiliates of MEC (Marunouchi Direct Access Limited, Mitsubishi Estate Building Management Co., Ltd. and MEC Information Development Co., Ltd.) likewise are authorized to provide telecommunications service in Japan.

(j) Applicant seeks to provide international telecommunications service between the United States and Japan notwithstanding the fact that Applicant is affiliated with a company that is authorized to provide telecommunications service in Japan as indicated in (i) above.

(k) The country named in (i) above, Japan, is a member of the World Trade Organization. No company named in (i) above is dominant in a relevant market in Japan.

(l) No company named in (i) above is dominant in a relevant market in Japan because each such company has less than a 50 percent market share in Japan in the international transport and local access service markets.

(m) Applicant should be regulated as a non-dominant carrier in the provision of international service along the U.S.-Japan route since none of the companies named in (i) is dominant in a relevant market and since Applicant will provide service along such route solely through the resale of an unaffiliated U.S. facilities-based carrier's international switched services (either directly or indirectly through the resale of another U. S. resale carrier's international switched services).

(n) Applicant has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any entity that engages in the provision of international or domestic

telecommunications services offered to the public in a foreign country with respect to any U.S. international route where such entity possesses market power on the foreign end of the route, and Applicant will not enter into any such agreement in the future.

(o) No party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

(p) Applicant requests streamlined processing of this application. Applicant is entitled to streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12(a) of the Commission's Rules since it is non-dominant with respect to the provision of telecommunications service between the U.S. and all foreign countries.
