Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 12, 2003, Telmex USA, L.I.C. ("Telmex USA") filed the above-referenced application for authority to offer international telecommunications services pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. In response to a question raised by the Commission's staff, this letter is to clarify the scope of Telmex USA's application.

By its application, Telmex USA seeks authority to provide global facilities-based international switched services to all international points. Further, Telmex USA requests authority to provide resold non-interconnected private line services to all international points. Finally, Telmex USA requests authority to provide interconnected private line service on routes where the Commission has already authorized the provision of such service. Telmex USA does not seek authority to provide interconnected private line service on the U.S.-Mexico route prior to the time the Commission grants authority to provide such services on that route.
