Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.21(h), TracFone Wireless, Inc (“TracFone”) submits a notification to the Commission that it provides service to some customers through its wholly-owned subsidiary, SafeLink Wireless, Inc. (“SafeLink Wireless”). SafeLink Wireless, a Delaware corporation, is a non-facilities-based provider of commercial mobile radio services only to certain South Carolina customers and offers U.S.-international telecommunications services as an optional, separate add-on service. The Commission has previously authorized TracFone to provide global resale services pursuant to Section 214.<sup>1</sup>

SafeLink Wireless commenced provision of U.S. international telecommunications services in January 2011 and has been authorized to do so pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.21(h) since that time. TracFone has been unable to confirm that a notification was made previously and therefore makes this notification out of an abundance of caution. TracFone regrets any paperwork oversight and believes that the public interest has not been harmed by any inadvertent omission pertaining to the requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 63.21(h). In particular, TracFone, on behalf of SafeLink Wireless, has complied with the Commission’s rules for such services on the assumption that SafeLink Wireless was authorized to operate pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.21(h).
