Thrane & Thrane Inc., (“Thrane & Thrane”), by undersigned attorneys, hereby voluntarily surrenders its International 214 Authorization (File Nos. ITC-214-20030424-00203/ITC-T/C-20030828-00422).

Thrane & Thrane does not provide service to any customers pursuant to this authorization and has not done so since at least May 1, 2009, when it completed a transfer of its customer base. Because the company does not currently provide services that require the Company to have an International 214 authorization, the Company is surrendering its Section 214 license effective immediately.<sup>1</sup>
