Dear Ms. Dortch:

CenturyLink, Inc. (CenturyLink), on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiaries, Savvis, Inc. and Savvis Communications Corporation (Savvis), hereby submits this letter to surrender the international Section 214 authorizations held by Savvis and issued in File Nos. ITC-214-20020627-00315 and ITC-214-20040122-00026.<sup>1</sup> CenturyLink requests that the surrender be effective immediately.

CenturyLink is in the process of selling its data centers and other related assets, which are held primarily in Savvis. In preparing for that sale and a related corporate internal reorganization, CenturyLink has determined that Savvis no longer provides (and does not have plans in the future to provide) international telecommunications services and therefore no longer requires the international Section 214 authorizations that are the subject of this letter. Because Savvis does not provide international telecommunications services, no customer will be affected by the surrender of these authorizations and no customer therefore need be notified in accordance with Section 63.19(a)(1) of the Commission's rules.
