SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Starvox Communications, Inc. ("Starvox") and its wholly-owned subsidiary,
Capital Telecommunications, Inc. ("CTI," and together with Starvox, "Applicants"),
hereby request authority pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934,
as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214 (the "Act"), and Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules,
47 CFR § 63.71, to discontinue their provision of domestic telecommunications services¹
in all states where the Applicants provide telecommunications services.² Although
Applicants did not anticipate the need to file this application,³ Applicants simply do not
have funding at this time sufficient to maintain the provisioning of service to their
customers.

Applicants also are discontinuing international services pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission's Rules, 47 CFR §63.19, and are serving a copy of this application and customer notification letter to the International Bureau.

Starvox provides service in the following states: California, D.C., Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, Utah, Virginia and Washington. CTI provides service in the following states: Connecticut, Delaware, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and Texas. Applicants are discontinuing international services in all of these states as well.

Indeed, pursuant to a purchase agreement, the Applicants filed for authority to transfer their assets and customers to a newly-formed company, bComm, Inc. ("bComm"), so that their customers would continue to receive the same services, rates, terms and conditions in a seamless manner from bComm. However, bComm decided to terminate the purchase agreement; thus, the Applicants have filed a request to withdraw their transfer applications.

It is likely that the Applicants will shortly be filing for Chapter 7 bankruptcy and liquidation and will have to discontinue service in the very near future. Currently, the Applicants' carrier suppliers are threatening to discontinue service to Starvox and CTI, and if that occurs, customers of the Applicants may experience unintended service outages. The Applicants mailed notices to their customers on February 12, 2008 informing them that they would no longer be the local or long distance telephone, internet or data service provider for those customers. Although these customers will not be transferred to bComm, they have adequate alternative services available to them from competitive local exchange, interexchange and incumbent service providers.

Applicants provide the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules:

- 1. <u>Name and Address of the Carrier:</u> Capital Telecommunications, Inc. is a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of Starvox Communications, Inc. Starvox is located at 2728 Orchard Parkway, San Jose, California 95134. CTI is located at 200 West Market Street, York, Pennsylvania 17401.
- 2. <u>Date of Planned Service Discontinuance, Reduction or</u>

 <u>Impairment</u>: The Applicants plan to discontinue service to customers as soon as

 Commission approval is obtained. Applicants understand that this application will be automatically granted on the 31st day after public notice of filing unless the Commission notifies the Applicants to the contrary.
- 3. <u>Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected</u>: Applicants will discontinue the provision of service to all of their customers in the states listed in footnote 1 above.

- 4. <u>Brief Description of Type of Service Affected</u>: Starvox is a non-dominant carrier authorized to provide switched and dedicated intrastate, interstate, and international long distance message toll telecommunications services to business, enterprise (multi-location businesses), and carrier customers on a retail and wholesale basis. Starvox provides retail long distance services to customers located in the states listed in footnote 1 above. Starvox provides international services pursuant to its Section 214 authorization.⁴ CTI is a non-dominant carrier authorized to provide traditional local, long distance and data services primarily to small and medium-sized businesses to customers located in the states listed in footnote 1 above. CTI provides international services pursuant to its Section 214 authorization.⁵
- 5. <u>Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All</u>

 <u>Affected Customers</u>: Applicants provided customers written notice by letter dated

 February 12, 2008 of the potential discontinuance. Applicants updated their customers regarding the discontinuance by letter dated March 17, 2008. The notices were sent by

 U.S. mail, postage prepaid. Copies of the notices are appended hereto as Exhibit A.
- 6. Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with Respect to the Service to be Discontinued, Reduced or Impaired: Applicants are considered non-dominant carriers with respect to the affected services.

Address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Washington, DC 20554 referencing the §63.71 Application of StarVox Communications Services, Inc. Comments should include specific information about the impact of the proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service. The transfer of your account to bComm is subject to the parties being able to close the transaction and obtaining the final approval of the state and federal regulatory authorities. We will notify you of any developments that affect the timing or details regarding the transfer of your service as soon as reasonably possible.

It has been the pleasure of CTI/StarVox to provide you with quality local, long distance and data communications services and we emphasize that you are a valued customer of CTI/StarVox and will be treated as such by bComm. You will automatically become a bComm customer and bComm will pay any change charges associated with the transfer of your account, unless, subject to any contractual obligations with CTI/StarVox, you choose another carrier within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. You may choose another carrier for your telephone service at any time in accordance with the terms of your contract.
