This letter is being filed to inform the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) that Intelsat USA License LLC (“Intelsat”) is hereby surrendering its international Section 214 authorization issued under File No. ITC-214-20051031-00443. Intelsat does not provide common carrier services to any customers pursuant to this authorization. The authorization is being surrendered as an administrative matter to update the FCC’s records.¹ Because Intelsat does not provide service to any customers pursuant to this authorization, the company is not required to provide notice of discontinuance pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19.
