Pursuant to Section 63.21(i) of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 63.21(i)), this notification is provided to inform the Commission that, effective October 15, 2008, Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company ("Southeast") changed its name to Southeast Nebraska Communications, Inc. Southeast was authorized to provide international global resale service on November 18, 2005 under File No. ITC-20051102-00448. See Public Notice, DA No. 05-3041, released November 25, 2005. Through an inadvertent oversight, this name change notification was not filed during the thirty (30) day time period required by Section 63.21(i) of the Commission's rules. Southeast regrets this oversights but respectfully submits that it believes that all affected customers were notified of the change in accordance with applicable requirements and that other paperwork notifications required of Southeast to, among other entities, the Universal Service Administrative Company, have been made.
