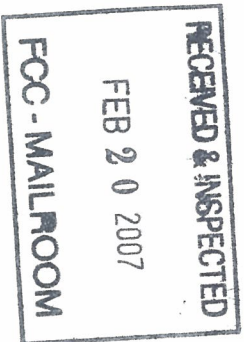

Dear Secretary Dortch:

Liberty Wireless, Corp. f/k/a Teleplus Wireless, Corp. (“Applicant”), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby amends its name on its Application for Section 214 Authority, which was accepted for filing pursuant to public notice on February 17, 2006.<sup>1</sup> The Applicant was formerly known as “Teleplus Wireless, Corp.” The Applicant’s new name, which took effect October 23, 2006, is “Liberty Wireless, Corp.” “Liberty Wireless, Corp. f/k/a Teleplus Wireless, Corp.” should replace “Teleplus Wireless, Corp.” on page 1 and Attachments 1, 2 and 3 of the Application.

In addition, the Applicant hereby amends the name of the company that owns 100% of the Applicant. The Applicant’s 100% owner was formerly known as “Teleplus Enterprises, Inc.” The new name of the Applicant’s 100% owner, which took effect October 24, 2006, is “Teleplus World, Corp.” “Teleplus World, Corp. f/k/a Teleplus Enterprises, Inc.” should replace “Teleplus Enterprises, Inc.” on Attachments 1 and 2 of the Application.

The name change from “Teleplus Wireless, Corp.” to “Liberty Wireless, Corp.” and from “Teleplus Enterprises, Inc.” to “Teleplus World, Corp.” are corporate name changes only. There was no corporate restructuring or reorganization of either company. Also, there has been no change in the ownership of the Applicant as a result of these name changes.

Dear Mr. Vanikiotis:

This letter dismisses an application filed by Teleplus Wireless, Corp. on February 8, 2006 for an International Section 214 Authorization to provide facilities-based and resale services in accordance with Sections 63.18(e)(1) and 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's rules. We dismiss this application without prejudice to refiling because of Teleplus Wireless, Corp.'s failure to pay its delinquent debts to the Commission.

Pursuant to Section 1.1910(a)(1) of the Commission's rules, the Commission examines each application to determine whether the applicant is delinquent in any non-tax debt owed to the Commission.<sup>1</sup> On May 12, 2007, your application again became redlighted because of delinquent debts owed to the Commission. On September 18, 2007, the Commission notified Teleplus Wireless, Corp. that it was delinquent on the payment of debts owed to the Commission.<sup>2</sup> The e-mail stated that if full payment or satisfactory arrangement to pay the delinquent debt was not made within 30 days of the date of the e-mail, Teleplus Wireless, Corp.'s application would be dismissed pursuant to Section 1.1910(b)(3) of the rules.<sup>3</sup> The Commission has not received payment of the debt identified in the e-mail, nor has Teleplus Wireless, Corp. made other satisfactory payment arrangements with the Commission.
