Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC (“MSV”), the United States L band Mobile Satellite Service (“MSS”) licensee, hereby files this letter regarding the above-referenced application filed by BT Fifty-Three Limited, a subsidiary of BT Group plc (“BT”), in which it requests international Section 214 authority to provide Inmarsat Broadband Global Area Network (“BGAN”) MSS on a common carrier basis between the United States and all international points using the uncoordinated Inmarsat 4F2 L band satellite.<sup>1</sup>

MSV is not opposed to BT’s request for Section 214 authority, but it has opposed the pending application of another BT subsidiary, BT Americas Inc., for long-term Title III authority to operate BGAN Mobile Earth Terminals (“METs”) with the uncoordinated Inmarsat 4F2 satellite.<sup>2</sup> MSV has opposed this application because of the harmful interference that will occur to MSV and other L band MSS operators in North America from operation of the uncoordinated BGAN service and the Inmarsat 4F2 satellite prior to a coordination agreement. To the extent the Bureau grants the above-referenced Section 214 application prior to action on BT’s pending application for a Title III MET license to operate BGAN terminals, MSV urges the Bureau to include an express condition that grant of this application is without prejudice to such future action.
