APPLICATION

Intranet Systems Technology, Inc. ("IST" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned President, hereby requests global facilities-based authority and global resale authority, under Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to provide international telecommunications services between the United States and international points.

I. THE APPLICANT

IST is a corporation formed on February 1, 1996 under the laws of the State of Florida. Applicant desires to provide international telecommunications services to individuals and businesses in the United States. IST has no affiliation with any foreign carrier in any of the destination countries for which authority is requested nor is IST affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose services IST may resell. Thus, pursuant to Section 63.10 (a)(1) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.10 (a)(1), IST should

be classified as a non-dominant carrier in its provision of international service on all routes. Furthermore, as explained herein, this Application is entitled to streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules. 47 C.F.R. § 63.12.

II. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

IST believes that the added competition its entry will bring to the market will benefit the consumers of United States-international telecommunications services. These benefits include competitive pricing and increased availability of a variety of innovative service options. Therefore, grant of this Application will further the public interest.

III. INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 63.18

IST submits the following information, as required by Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, in support of this Application:

- (d) IST does not currently hold any Section 214 authorizations.
- (e) IST requests global Section 214 authority to operate as a facilities-based and resale international carrier pursuant to Sections 63.18(e)(1) and 63.18(e)(2), respectively, of the Commission's Rules. IST requests such authorization for all international routes authorized by the Commission.
- (f) IST seeks Section 214 authorization to provide only the services referenced under paragraph (e) of Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules.
- (g) IST will use previously authorized facilities to provide the services requested by the Application. Consequently, IST is categorically excluded from environmental assessment pursuant to Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules. 47 C.F.R. § 1.1306.
- (h) Information regarding the 10% or greater direct or indirect owners of Applicant is as follows.

 - (2) Lillian Rebeca Zuniga is a natural person. No other person or entity owns or controls more than 10% directly or indirectly of Intranet Systems Technology, Inc.

Applicant does not have any interlocking directorates with a foreign carrier.

- (i) IST certifies that it is not affiliated with a foreign carrier.
- (j) IST certifies that it does not seek to provide international telecommunications services to any destination country for which any of the following is true:

- (1) The Applicant is a foreign carrier in that country; or
 - (2) The Applicant controls a foreign carrier in that country; or
 - (3) Any entity that owns more than twenty-five percent (25%) of Applicant, or that controls the Applicant, controls a foreign carrier in that country.
 - (4) Two or more foreign carriers (or parties that control foreign carriers) own, in the aggregate, more than twenty-five percent (25%) of Applicant and are parties to, or the beneficiaries of, a contractual relation (e.g., a joint venture or market alliance) affecting the provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.
- (k) Not applicable.
- (l) Not applicable. Applicant does not propose to resell the international switched services of an unaffiliated U.S. carrier for the purpose of providing international telecommunications services to a country where it is a foreign carrier or is affiliated with a foreign carrier.
- (m) Not applicable.
- (n) IST certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier where the foreign carrier possesses market power on the foreign end of the route and IST will not enter into such agreements in the future.
- (o) IST certifies, pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Commission's Rules (implementing the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862), it is not subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
- (p) IST respectfully requests streamlined processing of this Application pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules. 47 C.F.R. § 63.12. This Application qualifies for streamlined processing for the following reasons: (1) IST is not affiliated with a foreign carrier on any route for which authority is sought; (2) IST is not affiliated with any dominant U.S. carrier whose international switched or private line services it seeks to resell; and (3) IST is not requesting authority to provide switched services over private lines to countries not previously authorized for service by the Commission.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Intranet Systems Technology, Inc. respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Application.

IST does not seek to provide international telecommunications service to any destination where (1) IST is a foreign carrier in that country; (2) IST controls a foreign carrier in that country; (3) any entity that owns more than a 25% interest in IST, or controls IST, controls a foreign carrier in that country; or (4) two or more parties own, in the aggregate, more than 25% of IST and are parties to, or beneficiaries of, a contractual relationship that affects that provision or marketing of international basic telecommunications services in the United States.
4. IST has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier with respect to any U.S. international route where the foreign carrier possesses sufficient market power on the foreign end of the route to affect competition adversely in the U.S. market and will not enter into such agreements in the future.
5. IST is not subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
